**Position:** Counselor-in-Training (CIT)

Classification: Volunteer within the Education Department

**Description:** CITs are volunteers ages 15-17 within our ZooCamp program.

Commitment: One week of summer ZooCamp

## **Summary of Responsibilities:**

CITs are volunteer participants, aged 15-17, who help with our summer ZooCamp program. They are supervised by ZooCamp staff and are responsible for assisting in maintaining a fun, safe, and educational environment for campers. CITs are expected to model good behaviors, assist campers to participate with camp crafts, games and activities, and encourage participation. CITs will practice their leadership skills, learn about conservation education and gain experience with classroom management, and working as part of a team, in a summer camp setting.

#### CITs will:

- Assist other CITs, Camp Counselors, and the ZooCamp Director with all aspects of camp for ages 4-10.
- Assist in before and after care for campers.
- Learn how to lead different components of ZooCamp including games, crafts, and activities.
- Learn about the animals that call Stone Zoo home to better teach campers.
- Learn how to handle select ambassador animals at the discretion of the Education Department Staff.

### **Qualifications:**

- Must be a student aged 15-17. Grade/age verification may be required.
- Must have completed at least one session of ZooCamp at Stone Zoo or Franklin Park Zoo as a camper.
- Must commit to one full week of summer ZooCamp, 8:30 am 3:30 pm, Monday Friday.
- Must commit to three mandatory trainings in the spring.
  - o Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> from 4:30 pm-5:30 pm (parent/guardian attendance required)
  - o Saturday, May 25<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 am-2:00 pm
  - o Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 pm-6:00 pm
- Arrive on time and stay for the entirety of their volunteer shift, with reliable transportation to and from the zoo.
- Enjoy interacting with children.
- An interest in conservation and zoos.
- A strong desire to uphold Zoo New England's messages, mission, and goals.
- Adhere to all ZooCamp and Zoo New England policies and procedures.

#### **Benefits:**

- Free year-round admission to Franklin Park Zoo/Stone Zoo for yourself.
- Resume-building skills and opportunities for professional development.
- Community service hours for school, sports teams, etc.

#### How to Apply:

- Teens must submit the completed application and Release Form that is signed by an adult.
- Please note: Applications must be completed and submitted by the applicant themselves. If applications are completed by or sent in by the parent/guardian, we will not move forward with your application. Applicants are welcome to copy a parent/guardian on any and all emails, but we are working to build young professionals and hope that by curating their own applications and emails, we're able to start the process.
